Priority Issue Areas (HRCC)

- 1. Affordable Housing Pursuing policies that will allow and attract the development of affordable housing throughout the Valley to support our diverse workforce needs.
- 2. **Child Care** Developing and supporting initiatives to assist our employers and employees find affordable childcare services, while simultaneously working to create a better regulatory environment for child care providers.
- 3. **Transportation/ Public Transit** Support the use, maintenance, and growth of our region's diverse transportation assets, such as airports, roadways, interstates, railroads, and in-land port of Virginia while also advocating for more solutions to our every growing public transit needs.

Policy Areas of Engagement (HRCC)

- 1. **Business Climate** Ensure the proper regulatory environment exists to allow businesses to grow while providing the necessary tools for effective economic development which will attract new business to the region.
